Arriving by car

Via the Cologne orbital motorway:

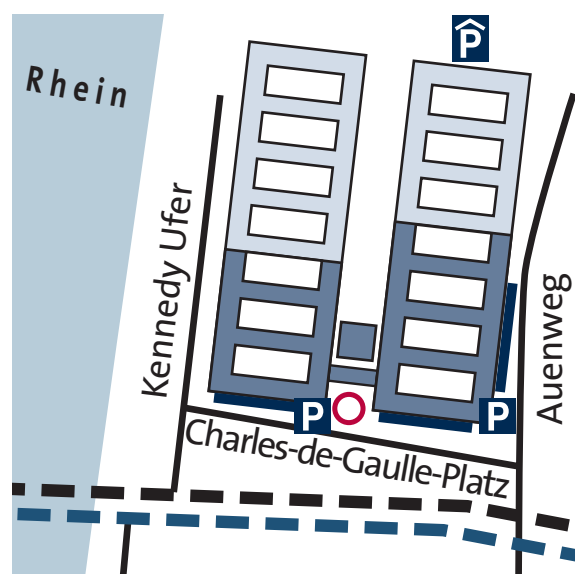
- **From the North and East** via the motorway junction Köln-Ost (A3/A4), then head towards the centre (Zentrum), exit Pfälzischer Ring/Messe, direction Deutz.
- **From the South and West** via the motorway junction Gremberg (A4/A59), then head towards Deutz/Messe.

The main access route is via Auenweg to Charles-de-Gaulle-Platz.

Location of parking spaces

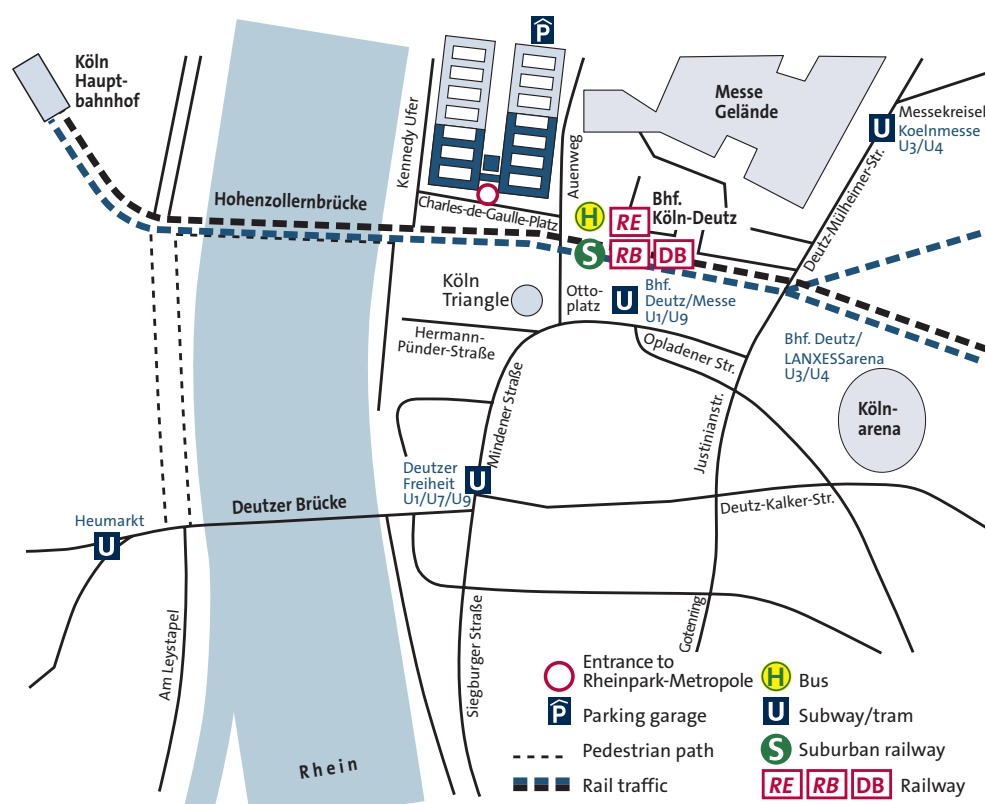
Vehicle parking for Talanx Asset Management is available in the Rheinpark-Metropole; spaces inside the parking garage on the north side are for staff, while open spaces on the south side of the building are intended for visitor parking. Motorcyclists can park free of charge in specially indicated spaces between the bicycle stands.

The entrance to the parking garage is located on Rheinparkweg, which branches off from Auenweg. The parking spaces in the parking garage can be reached via two barrier systems to the right and left of the South entrance on Charles-de-Gaulle-Platz. A valid parking space rental agreement is required in order to use the parking spaces. Parking spaces can be reserved for guests.

Arriving by German Railways

The ICE mainline railway station Köln Messe/Deutz is in the immediate vicinity of the Rheinpark-Metropole. Some ICE trains stop at Cologne Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) instead of the Köln Messe/Deutz station.

The following suburban railway lines (S-Bahn) leave from platform 10 of the central station for the mainline railway station Köln Messe/Deutz at frequent intervals:

S 6 (direction Essen), **S 11** (direction Bergisch Gladbach), **S 12** (direction Hennef-Sieg), **S 13** direction Troisdorf)

The suburban railway line (S-Bahn) 13 also links the Rheinpark-Metropole with Cologne/Bonn international airport. The journey time is 12 minutes.

The following local trains and expresses stop at the mainline railway station Köln Messe/Deutz: **RB 24, RB 25, RB 27, RB 38, RB 48, RE 1, RE 5, RE 7, RE 8, RE 9, RE 12, RE 22.**

Arriving on local public transport

Within the city the Rheinpark-Metropole is ideally connected with the local public transit system (ÖPNV).

Lines 3 and 4 call at the tram stops "Koelnmesse" and "Bahnhof Deutz/LANXESSarena".

The tram stops "Bahnhof Deutz/Messe" and "Deutzer Freiheit" are additionally served by lines 1 and 9.

The tram stop "Deutzer Freiheit" is also served by line 7.

In addition, bus lines 150, 250 and 260 call at the bus stop Bahnhof Deutz/Messeplatz.
